OBJECTIVES:

- To gather information from the community through a variety of methods to gain an understanding of their needs, desires and concerns and to address issues arising within the project plants,
- Through consultation with the appropriate resources, the Bishop Grandin Greenway task force will reclaim natural space and reinstate natural habitats that have been compromised by past development.
- To create and maintain a continuous trail and min trails that facilitates recreation activities, remain universally accessible* to the public of all ages, and ensures the safety an security of the users and surrounding community.
- To create an awareness and communication campaign that verbalizes the development of the plans and invites input and feedback from the community.
- To create a fundraising plan that ensures the sustainability of the project.
- To research similar projects to gain insights into pitfalls, other options, as well as solutions that ensure safety and security for those in the adjacent neighbourhood.
- To create thematic venues of space that highlight active living, wellness, history, education and nature appropriate to the various landscape along Bishop Grandin.
